Quality Improvement

St. John's Villa is excited to announce it started its Direct Support Assistant Program for high-school students, age 16-18, during 2023.

At this time, there are six students participating in the program, which provides support services to individuals residing in the residential homes at St. John's Villa. The goal is to have one for each of the seven residences.

Participants in the DSA program have expressed interest in the healthcare field with plans of a career in the field.

"This is an awesome job experience (for those interested in the developmental-disabilities field)," explains Mary Fe Dearth, director of Quality Improvement. "This gives the students opportunities for job exploration."

House Manager Pam Chalmers notes, "The program provides the students with hands-on experience in a career they are planning to pursue while earning money for college."

Quality Improvement Coordinator Holly Hutchison agrees, "The students are getting a chance to fine tune their career plans by determining what they like or don't like about the jobs. This allows them to focus on their interests as they plan for their careers."

The DSAs are under the direction of the house manager and adhere to the individuals' Individual Service Plan. They also provide a positive and rewarding home-like experience for the residents and serve a positive role model for the individuals served.

While the DSAs assist the individuals with their housekeeping tasks, they do not provide personal care, transport, administer medication, or implement behavior supports. Since

the DSAs are in high school, they usually work the afternoon shift and/or weekends.

The individuals have been very receptive and enjoy having the teens around. This program helps provide more one-on-one time to the residents and provides more opportunities for activities in the home.

The DSAs are making a positive impact on the residents. Hutchison recounts how two residents have become more active and are exercising. A DSA assisted another resident to create a healthy snack list, and go online to determine which snacks fit their budget. On shopping day, the resident stuck to their list to purchase healthier snacks.
